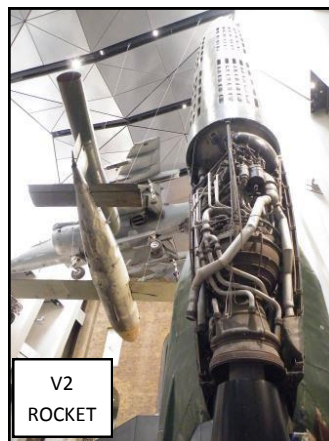


HTW Trip To The Imperial War Museum, 16th November, 2016
